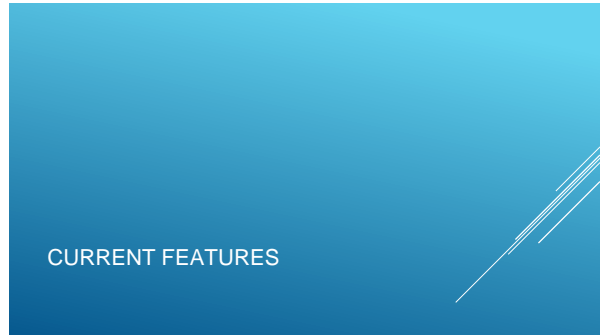
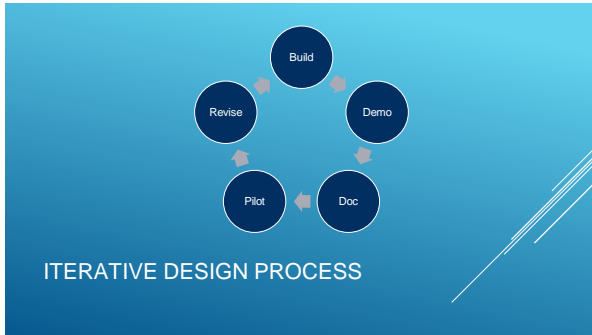

- Familiar with this student paradigm, Library Services worked with the IRT department to create a joint project to develop an assignment calculator.
- The first step was to investigate open source tools to find one that could present motivated students with a step-by-step personalized framework for success on each assignment.
